The main task of this assignment is to develop a requirements document.

1. Requirements Document

In this assignment each team has to write a requirements document for the whole game. The document shall be structured as in the provided template.

3.2 First Draft

You have to commit a first draft. This version will not be graded but it is mandatory to commit the first draft. Not committing the first draft implies failing the course. We recommend committing your document frequently.

What is a first draft?

A first draft of a requirements document is a document where 85% of the sections have been described, and the **critical requirements** have been defined. However, the document still needs improvements such as typos, grammar, etc.
